

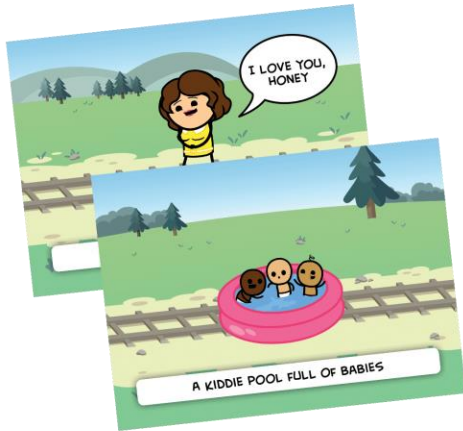
How To Play



Step 1: Choose one of your friends to be the conductor. The rest of you break into two teams.



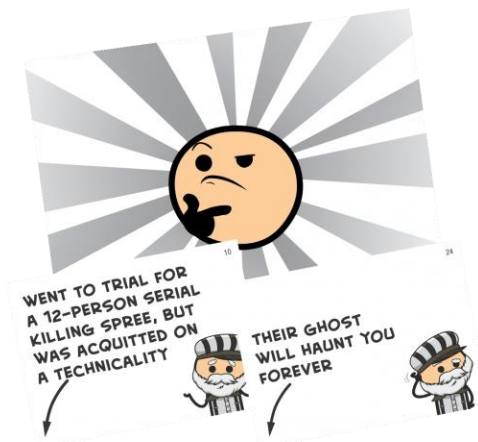
Step 2: Each track gets a random “innocent” card to start them off



Step 3: Each team plays another “innocent” card on their track. I sure wouldn’t want to hit either of those.



Step 4: Each team sabotages the other track with a “guilty” card. Oh, those are bad!



Step 5: Then each player plays modifier cards onto any character on either track to help sway the conductor to their side.



Step 6: Everyone argues for their lives, and the conductor decides which track to murder!



How to play while social distancing

As most of us are adjusting to life locked in our homes, we wanted to share a new variation on Trial by Trolley that allows you to play the game remotely with friends who don't own the game. This is just a simplified ruleset that keeps things moving so that you can get to the fun part and argue about who you think deserves to get murdered by a trolley!

How to Practice Safe Trolleying

Whichever one of you new shut-ins has a physical copy of the game is the **Trolley Master**. Now choose a player to be the conductor and divide everyone else into two teams just like you normally would.

Now just go through the regular rules like you would if you could actually leave your house to see your friends.

But since you can't very well deal out cards to everyone through your webcam, here's how this part is going to work:

How to make the tracks:

When it's a player's turn to add a track to the board, the Trolley Master draws two cards from the appropriate deck, reads them both aloud, and lets the player making the choice choose which of those two cards they want to add to the track.

How to add modifiers:

When it's time for a player to place a modifier, the Trolley Master draws a single card and reads it aloud. The player making the choice then gets to choose which character on the tracks will get that modifier.

That's it! Everything else is the same.

What's included



Each pack includes 520 game cards. 200 innocence cards, 150 guilty cards, and 175 modifier cards.
